Background/Purpose:

School funds (whether public or school-raised) and facilities must not be used for the purchase or consumption of alcohol.

Policy Statement:

The Board of Directors believes that the consumption of alcohol in schools or at school-sponsored student functions is inappropriate. The Board also believes that school funds should not be used for the purchase of alcoholic beverages.

Guidelines:

1. The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in: (i) schools; and (ii) all student functions, whether held on school property or elsewhere.
2. Subject to the approval of the Superintendent, the consumption of alcoholic beverages may be permitted outside of school property at school-sponsored functions that do not include students. Subject to the Superintendent’s approval, students may be permitted to perform or attend events at venues where alcoholic beverages are available.
3. No funds belonging to or administered by the school may be used to purchase or reimburse anyone for the purchase of alcohol. This includes monies from fundraising campaigns conducted by any person or entity affiliated with the school.
